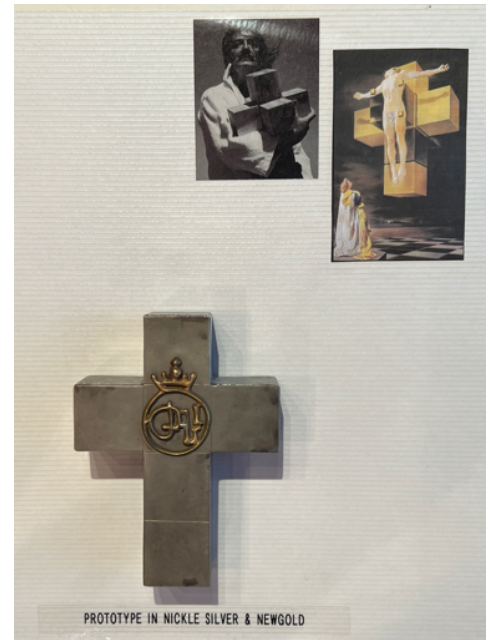

Dali Museum

I hired a car and driver to take me to Figueres, Spain, it is about 1 1/2 hours each way from Barcelona. I wanted to go to the Salvador Dali Museum. Figueres is the capital of the comarca of Alt Empordà, in the province of Girona, Catalonia, Spain. The town is the birthplace of Salvador Dali and houses the Teatre-Museu Sala Salvador Dali, a large museum designed by Dali himself. Salvador Domingo Felipe Jacinto Dali I Domenech, Marquess of Dalí of Púbol GCYC was a Spanish surrealist artist renowned for his technical skill, precise draftsmanship, and the striking and bizarre images in his work. Dali received his formal education in fine arts in Madrid. The museum incorporates the building that housed the town's theatre during Dali's childhood and is also the place where as a young artist he had his first public exhibition. The museum has a huge collection of Dali's works, including 3D installations like the Rainy Taxi and the anamorphic too the Sala Mae West in which the face of Mae West is revealed when viewed from a certain angle. The museum is also Dali's final resting place with the crypt located under the stage.

Dali's wife Gala died June 10, 1982 and in the mid 80's I won the commission to do 250 pieces for Dali in Sterling Silver & Gold as a remembrance to his wife and I wanted to see if any of my pieces were in the museum. Sorry to say I did not find any. They did have a large collection of his gold and precious gem pieces which I really enjoyed seeing.
