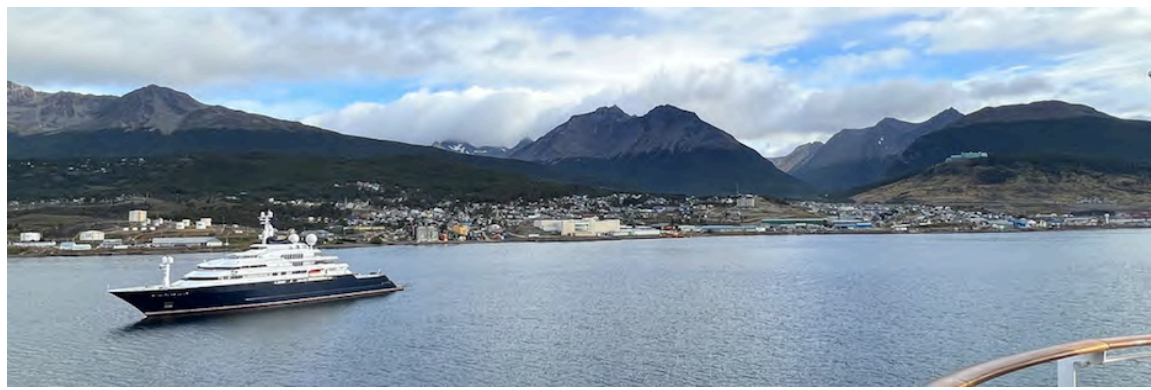
Yesterday we sailed the South Atlantic Ocean along the Argentinean coast and in the afternoon around 12:00 we sailed between the “Magellan Strait” on our starboard side at a distance of 85 Nautical Miles, and the “Falkland Island” on our port side at a distance of 80 Nautical Miles. At the end of the day, around 23:00 we were abeam of “La Tierra del Fuego” at a distance of 8 Nautical Miles, as the San Diego Lighthouse became visible.



Ushuaia is a resort town in Argentina. Its located on the Tierra del Fuego archipelago, the southernmost tip of South America, nicknamed the “End of the World.” The windswept town, perched on a steep hill, is surrounded by the Martial Mountains and the Beagle Channel. It’s the gateway to Antarctica cruises and tours to nearby Isla Yecapasela, know as “Penguin Island” for its penguin colonies. When we arrived this morning the dock was full there were 5 ship either cruise ships or yachts so we had to anchor in the bay and tender to shore. Tonight the large Celebrity cruise ship will depart and we will take her place at the dock for our second day in Uhuaia.
