Today we are in the Coral Sea headed to Cairns, Australia. The Coral Sea has an average annual temperature that varies according to the latitude in which we are. For example, in the southern part waters are colder that are around 19 degrees. On the other hand we have the northern part, warmest waters with values around 24 degrees. In the meteorology of this sea we find strong tropical cyclones that are quite frequent in it. Tropical cyclones occur most frequently during the summer season.

The distance between Alotau and Cairns is 507 nautical miles an our cruising speed will be 14.7 knots.
