The MSC Magnifica will continue its navigation in the Tasmanian Sea with a North Northern-East course headed to Sydney. The distance separating Hobart & Sydney is 636 nautical miles and our cruising speed is about 19 knots. In the afternoon around 16:00 on our portside at a distance of 17 Nautical Miles Gabo Island. Gabo Island is a 154-hectare island located off the coast



of eastern Victoria, Australia, between Mallacoota and Cape Howe on the border with New South Wales. It is separated from the mainland by a 500-metre wide channel; access is available by arranged flights and boats. Small island known for its tall pink-granite lighthouse, with a rocky coastline & forest.

90% of Australians live on the coast. The large deserts of central Australia mean that the vast majority of the population live on the shores of this enormous country. The large cities of Perth, Sydney and Melbourne are iconic places to visit, with buzzing centers and a multitude of beaches, from the sands of Bondi to the surf of Trigg.
