Having left the port of Aqaba we continued sailing in the Gulf of Suez between the Sinai Peninsula on the starboard side at a distance of 8 nautical miles and Egypt on the port side at a distance of 10 nautical miles. Then we proceeded to the convoy point and wait for our turn to cross the Suez Canal. We will enter the Suez Canal at around 04:00 and exit between 15:00 and 16:00 on April 27.

Sinai Peninsula, or simply Sinai is a peninsula in Egypt, and the only part of the country located in Asia. It is between the Mediterranean Sea to the north and the Red Sea to the south, and is a land bridge between Asia and Africa. Sinai has a land area of about 60,000 km (6 percent of Egypt's total area) and a population of approximately 600,000 people. Administratively, the vast majority of the area of the Sinai Peninsula is divided into two govern orates: the South Sinai Governorate and the North Sinai Governorate. Three other govern orates span the Suez Canal, crossing into African Egypt: Suez Governorate on the southern end of the Suez Canal, Ismailia Governorate in the center, and Port Said Governorate in the north.
